Frontier School Division Workplace Safety and Health Program

1. Objectives

The objectives of the Frontier School Division Workplace Safety and Health Program are:

- a. to assist workers and Frontier School Division to identify, record, examine, evaluate and resolve safety and health concerns in the workplace,
- b. to develop practical procedures and conditions to encourage a high degree of safety and health in the workplace,
- c. to promote and provide education and training programs to develop knowledge of safety and health concerns and to make individuals aware of the roles they have in maintaining a safe work environment.
