

HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Policy F.1.C

Frontier School Division shall provide all students with access to high school programming to the completion of Grade 12. If the Division is unable to provide this programming in a local school, then a variety of delivery options are available to assist students to graduate.

High school program delivery options could include any of the following, or a combination of more than one of the following:

- a. a local school with Grade 12 programming,
- b. any Frontier School Division high school with Grade 12 programming,
- c. other provincial high schools (Frontier School Division students who are living on provincial land attend these schools through the Home Placement Program. Treaty and non-treaty students living on reserve must access the local education authority's Private Home Placement (PHP) program),
- d. distance education (Independent Study Option, WebCT),
- e. home schooling (inform parents as an option).
