Megan McIvor's dream was to become an educator, and provide an enriching experience to everyone she encountered both in and out of the classroom. Megan was very active in her studies and her community; these qualities are the foundation of the Frontier family.

This memorial fund would provide an annual scholarship to a Frontier School Division PENT student pursuing an Education degree from Brandon University.

- The scholarship will be awarded annually to a Frontier School Division PENT student who has a high academic standing within the PENT Program. Eligible students must be taking a full load (8 courses) in the PENT Program.
- The successful applicant will be chosen based on his/her academic performance and involvement in extra curricular activities both in his/her home school and Brandon University. Applicants submit a short essay of 300-500 words outlining their extra curricular involvement and peer support to their fellow PENT students. Applicants must also submit an academic transcript from Brandon University. The Board of Directors of N.O.F.I. will review the essay and marks. If, in any given year, the essay and marks submitted are not of acceptable quality, the scholarship will not be dispersed for that year.
- The successful applicant will receive the scholarship in October following the summer courses.
- Applicants may receive the scholarship twice during their training but not in consecutive years.
- Applicants will be evaluated on their academic performance, community involvement, extracurricular activities and leadership qualities.
- The amount of the scholarship is \$500.00.
