

Education Agreements are legal contracts through which Frontier School Division provides educational services and programs to an outside organization. These agreements may be between the Division and a First Nation, or the Division and organizations such as Manitoba Hydro. There are also reciprocal agreements to cover Frontier School Division students attending First Nation schools.

The Frontier School Board of Trustees is supportive of Education Agreements which enable the Division to provide high quality education services to students throughout the province. Guidelines and procedures for the development of new agreements and the renewal of existing agreements are established by the Board.

All agreements must be approved by motion by the Board of Trustees.
