

Risk management is the process of planning, organizing and controlling the activities of the Division to minimize the potential for hazards and accidents. The Board of Trustees of Frontier School Division believes that a risk management program covering all Division operations must be in place to ensure the safety of students and employees. The Frontier School Division program identifies areas of risk, establishes processes to minimize such risks, and outlines procedures to reduce the adverse effects of accidental losses, including application of Division insurance policies.

Frontier School Division will develop and distribute Risk Management Guidelines which will outline procedures to address safety issues throughout the Division. Included in this document will be guidelines for student safety both in the school and during out-of-school experiences. The Division will incorporate the YouthSafe Manitoba program into the Division's program and will distribute it to all schools. The use of these guidelines is mandatory for all out-of-school experiences.
