

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR A FRONTIER SCHOOL DIVISION DIPLOMA

Policy F.3.C

Frontier School Division is committed to providing all learners with an inclusive and culturally relevant education that supports and advances Indigenous Education and the work of reconciliation. Indigenous knowledge, lived experiences, and languages will be included across the curriculum. All students will learn about our collective Canadian history including the historical and contemporary contributions made by Indigenous peoples of Canada.

Grades 9-12

Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning (MEECL) provides the authority for a school division to mandate additional credits for graduation. Students meeting the additional requirements are eligible for the school division diploma, in addition to the provincial diploma.

- **Provincial Diploma**: Students who meet the provincial 30 credit requirement, are eligible for the Manitoba High School Diploma.
- **Division Diploma**: Students who meet the provincial 30 credit requirement are eligible for a Frontier School Division Diploma, if they complete a minimum of one (1) credit within the 30 credit requirement of an Indigenous focused School-initiated Course (SIC) or an Indigenous focused course from the current year's Subject Table Handbook (MEECL).

Adult Education students are exempt from this policy.

This policy is effective September 1, 2025.
