### BOARD and SENIOR ADMINISTRATION MEETING

The Board met with senior administration to review the Division's Strategic Plan focus areas of Academics, Indigenous Way of Life, and Student Services and Wellness, as well as a revisit of discussions arising from their fall meeting with senior leadership on school planning, community voice and paths for future goals.

#### 2025/26 BUDGET

The Board approved the Division's Budget for 2025/26. The Budget is based upon the Division's Strategic Plan and provides continued emphasis on the three focus areas.
