- Must meet the requirements under the regulations for entry and progression in the trade
- Knowledge of the duties of mechanic trades which includes maintaining, servicing, repairing and modifying transport trucks
- Knowledge of standard practices, methods, tools and equipment relating to mechanical maintenance and repair
- Knowledge of Provincial standards and requirements relative to operation and maintenance of transport trucks, including electronic troubleshooting
- Knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions of the trade
- Training in or understanding of WHMIS requirements
- Good verbal and written communication skills, planning and organizational skills
- Ability to understand and follow instructions
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships, work independently and as part of a team
- Safety footwear required
- Physically capable of lifting up to 25 kg
